

Violet Crown Festival 2016

An invitation to reach out and contribute to your community

Violet Crown Community Works (VCCW) invites businesses to contribute and have a presence at the **Violet Crown Festival**, which will be held at Brentwood Elementary School (6700 Arroyo Seco, in the west-side parking lot on Yates) from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. on **Saturday, May 7, 2016**.

The event is a project of VCCW, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that helps build and sustain community in the Brentwood and Crestview neighborhoods through the support of neighborhood enhancement projects. Past projects have included the Wall of Welcome at the Crestview Shopping Center (violetcrowncommunity.org/wall.html), Violet Crown Community Theatre, Voices of the Violet Crown, Friends of Brentwood Park, and Urban Patchwork Neighborhood Farms (at Brentwood Elementary).

In addition to over fifty local artists offering their wares, the festival includes activities for children and families and information about community resources. Visitors can enjoy local food and beverages while listening to live music. Admission is free and festival proceeds benefit current VCCW's projects in the neighborhood.

Last year, festival proceeds helped support the McCallum Royal Knights, a theatre troupe at the local high school. This year some of the proceeds will help support Crestview's Art at Entrances initiative. The VCCW Board is presently seeking input for additional neighborhood projects.
